First, I'd like to thank you for adhering to our spring cleanup procedures. Spring cleanup is a very important task that we really need your help with. Being already stretched thin, our board cannot accomplish our spring chores without the help of our 4-H and FFA community.

Attached you will find a color map of the fairgrounds and a list with your club's assigned cleanup area. Assignments were made based on club size. This map and list will also be posted in the Mini Park for reference. Please rake all leaves and sticks into the roads in piles and pick up all trash and place in trash cans in your respective areas. If your assigned area includes one of the open sided buildings, such as the show arenas, swine barn, sheep barn, etc. please blow or rake out leaves into the road in piles. Families are responsible for bringing their own yard equipment/tools.

Cleanups must be completed between **April 2<sup>nd</sup> and April 16<sup>th</sup>**. All club members are expected to participate in the cleanup to earn their Fair passes. Fairboard will be monitoring the progress and will contact you if your areas are not left in satisfactory condition. If an area is not left in satisfactory condition as determined by the Fairboard, that club's members will not receive free passes to the 2023 Fair. This will be strongly enforced. The campground restrooms will be open during the cleanup time. What a great way to get the kids out of the house and blow off some cooped up energy!

Thank you for helping us with this first official activity on the Fairgrounds, helping us to prepare for the busy year ahead! With the grass starting to grow, and many events on the horizon, we have limited time to get the grounds tiptop. We are working diligently on planning the fair. 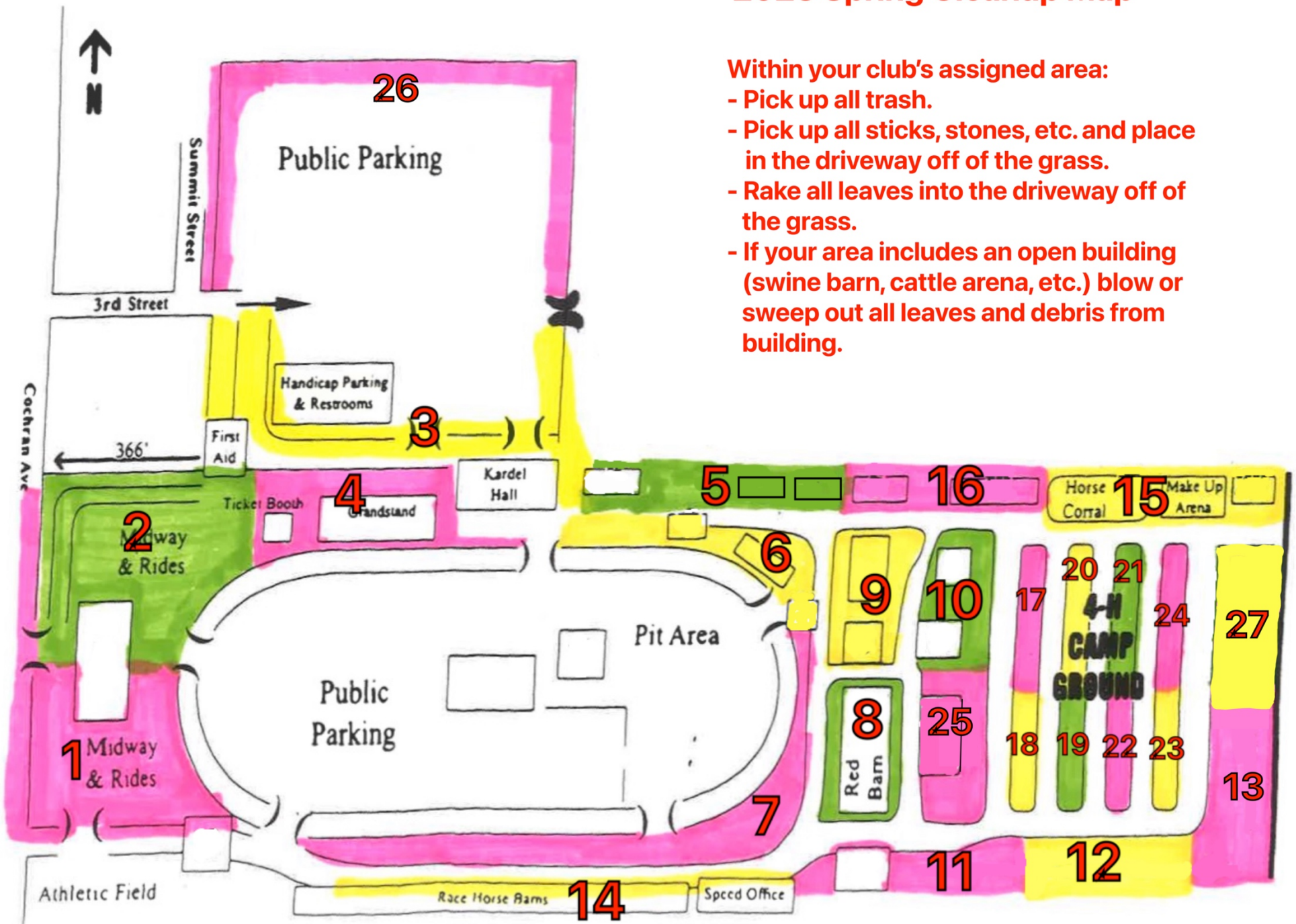
