

## Dairy Market Vaccination Letter

Dear 4-H Leader or FFA Advisor,

After contacting some of the buyers it is obvious that they want them vaccinated. This was the rule a few years ago so buyers assumed that all animals they bought were vaccinated. To make sure we don't lose buyers we need to do this.

All dairy starters must be vaccinated for IBR, BVD Types 1 & 2, PI3, BRSV, and bovine pneumonia. They also need a booster for the diseases in question. We will need either a vet note or a receipt showing the purchase of the vaccine to be able to have the animals marked as vaccinated. ALL ANIMALS SOLD IN THE SALE MUST BE VACCINATED. If you are taking it home you have the option to not vaccinate them.

I am including one product that most people I have spoken with use. I would recommend working together and buying for a larger group such as a club but the dose needs to be used within 12 hours after it is mixed up. One concern that I know people will have is that the vaccine is sold as a 5 or 10 dose bottle. **I am willing to buy more doses that you would have to come and get at the correct time to save you money if you only have a few animals.
