

Dairy Steer (big ones) & Dairy Starter Tagging and Fair Entry information

Dairy Beef Steer (big ones) Leaders or Parents of Exhibitors will need to pick-up tags from Caledonia Farmer's Elevator Charlotte, ask for Lisa Shilling, and have it placed in the right ear by February 28th, 2026.

- Dairy steers (big ones) that were shown as feeders last year can keep last year's tag. If you have a new one that wasn't shown you need to get ear tag.
 - DAIRY & DAIRY CROSSBRED FEEDERS: One tag per animal will need to be placed in the right ear of the animal by May 1, 2026. Vaccination paperwork must be turned in on June 1 along with dairy market pen request form.

DAIRY STEERS ANIMAL ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

After tagging the animal the following 3 photos need to be taken and uploaded to fairentry.com

- Headshot of the animal showing the FAIR tag. The tag needs to be readable.
- A picture of the RFID tag must be readable.
- ¾ body shot of the right side of animal with youth at the halter. The ear tag needs to be readable.
- Families that have yet to decide which youth is exhibiting which animal that is fine but still have a youth at the halter

DAIRY STARTERS ANIMAL ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

After tagging the animal the following 4 photos need to be taken and uploaded to fairentry.com

- Proof of vaccination (picture of vet note or receipt for vaccine purchased)-NEW THIS YEAR
- Headshot of the animal showing the FAIR tag. The tag needs to be readable.
- A picture of the RFID tag must be readable.
- ¾ body shot of the right side of animal with youth at the halter. The ear tag needs to be readable.
- Families that have yet to decide which youth is exhibiting which animal that is fine but still have a youth at the halter
