CAMP FEES

Camp Unit - \$70 (Includes admission for one auto but **not** driver)

Cook Unit - \$40 (Does not include admission or car pass)

Early Bird Fee - \$20 (See rule #7)

Camping fees and reservation forms can be mailed to the Fair Office, P.O. Box 38, Charlotte, MI 48813 - Attn: Fair Board Treasurer. Checks or money orders will be accepted. Club camping forms and reservations must be received by **May 3th**. After deadline, entries will be charged a late fee of \$30, for a total fee of \$100, and will be placed wherever there is available space. In order to have your club's units together the clubs should send their reservations and money in together.

No reservations accepted after the second Friday in June.

Camping forms may be picked up at the same time you get your entry forms. **EACH UNIT MUST** fill out and return a copy of the 5x8 registration card. **EACH CLUB MUST** fill out a club camp summary form, and **ALL FORMS AND CAMPING FEES** must be in our hands before we will reserve your space. Make checks payable to:

“Eaton County Agriculture Society”.

The camp office will be in the campground. Each unit must register at the camp office and get their registration card before being placed. This can be done by the club. Be sure that the person bringing in the unit knows which club it is with.

Because of the limited amount of space we have, please get your units in far enough so you can park between them and NOT have any portion of your vehicle or unit within the designated roadways. The minimum **CLEAR roadway width of 14 feet** will be strictly enforced. All campers and camp vehicles must fit within designated club sites. In the event that camp vehicles will not fit in designated club site; vehicles shall park outside the back gate, **NOT** elsewhere in the campground.

CAMPGROUND RULES

1. Only livestock exhibitors, leaders and livestock superintendents are allowed to camp.
2. Anyone under the age of 18 must be under the direct supervision of a parent/guardian during your stay at the fair.
3. All horse/stock trailers with living quarters must be approved by the Fair Board committee prior to the camping registration deadline.
4. Exhibitors will camp and sleep only in the camping areas.
5. No part of any camp unit is to be placed closer than **3 feet** from any electrical box or **4 feet** from any portion of another camp unit.

6. No permanent hoses on water hydrants.
7. For a \$20 Early Bird camping fee, campers can be brought onto the grounds on Thursday, **July 4th** from 5:00pm until 9:00pm. Please pay at the back campground gate.
8. Campers will not be brought into the camp area until Friday, **July 5th** at 9:00am, unless you pay the \$20 early bird fee.
9. Campfires must be contained in barrels, grills, etc.
10. No alcoholic beverages and/or illegal substances allowed on fairgrounds.
11. Please do not rely on electric fry pans, cookers or roasters, if at all possible. No electric stoves in cook tents.
12. No washing of clothes, dishes, hair or etc. at the water hydrants.
13. To reduce the risk of introducing or transferring pathogens or other health problems no pets are allowed in the campgrounds or in livestock exhibit areas after 6:00 ^{pm} on Sunday. The only exception is clover bud show day.
14. No horses allowed in the camp area, except on designated roads when you are going to an exercise area.
15. No horse or livestock trailers are to be parked in the camp area or outside the back gate. Please take them home for the week.
16. Only vehicles with camper passes are allowed to use the camp gate. These are the **ONLY** vehicles that are allowed to park in the camping area. Unauthorized vehicles parked illegally will be towed at the owner's expense. Cars or trailers parked outside of back gate may be towed away by the city.
17. All designated roads and driveways are required to provide a **14 foot wide** clear egress route and must be kept clear and open at all times. Vehicles encroaching into or blocking any portions of these egress routes will be towed at owner's expense. This is to accommodate fire, emergency and police traffic.
18. No bicycles allowed on the fairgrounds.
19. Generators allowed 6:00 ^{am} to 9:00 ^{pm}.
20. ALL garbage **MUST** be in plastic bags and placed at the edge of the road in campground by 9:00am.
21. The camp curfew is 12:30 ^{am} every night.
22. At their discretion the Fair Board reserves the right to ask any person or group to leave the fairgrounds.
23. No campers are allowed to leave early without written approval of the Campground Superintendent and the Fair Board. Removal of a camper without written approval may **prohibit** your approval to camp in the following year.
24. **No air conditioners may be run from the campgrounds electrical power.** Air conditioners may be run from portable generators between 6:00 ^{am} and 9:00 ^{pm}.
