GENERAL RULES
Judging Thursday @ 9:00 a.m.

1. All Llamas/Alpacas must have up-to-date shots.
2. All Llamas/Alpacas must be in designated pens by Sunday at 7:00p.m.
3. All Llamas/Alpacas will be released from the fair on Sunday, **July 17th at 6:00a.m.**
4. Llamas /Alpacas need not to be owned by exhibitors to be exhibited.
5. Llamas /Alpacas are to be exercised only by the exhibitor or a member of their immediate family.
6. Animals are to be worked/exercised only in show area. Llamas /Alpacas are not to be anywhere else on the fairgrounds except by special permission of superintendent.
7. Llama/Alpaca pens are to be kept neat and clean of manure.
8. Brushing and blowing is to be done in designated areas only.
9. Aisles in the barn are to be kept neat and clean.
10. Showmanship contestants are to wear white blouses with black pants or skirts.
11. There will be a manure disposal fee of \$3 per llama/alpaca. Fees are due on June 1st. Each clubs total pen fees must accompany their pen reservations to the superintendent.
12. Livestock exhibitors must be in compliance with animal health requirements as defined by the department.

13. Showmanship age as of January 1st of the current year.
14. Exhibits removed by any person or persons prior to release without permission and early release form signed by both their superintendent and fairboard liaison will forfeit placements, ribbons or trophies for that exhibit and will not be allowed to enter exhibits the following year.
