Below are the rules out of the fair book for tag in.

Eaton County Fair Book-Beef

-All Market Beef must be tagged in from February 1st 2024 to February 29th 2024, with pictures and animal profiles to be uploaded by February 29th 2024 of the current year, or they are not eligible for show or sale. Market Beef animals must be owned by the exhibitor by February 15th of the current year.

**RFID TAGS MUST BE CLEAR AND VISIBLE ON ALL CATTLE, Please include RFID tag, tag in tag, body and head shots with exhibitors. PLEASE ADVISE.... RFID tags, tag in numbers and tattoo numbers (if applicable example: breeding heifers) must match in order to show at the fair.

-Exhibitors are allowed to tag in up to 5 Market Beef.

-Youth are limited to exhibiting 5 breeding animals, (2 market beef steers and/or heifers, 2 feeders and/or 1 carcass animal) per exhibitor.
